





# List of parts






- Begin by connecting the **bottom shelf** between **A** bars to **B** bars on both sides. Tighten the parts together by hand.
- 2 Repeat the process with the middle shelf and second set of B bars.
- 3 Finish the step by securing the top shelf in place with top bolts.

## Step 2


## Assembling diagonal legs.



Assemble the bottom C bar and top D bar with Type 3 screws.
 Use the L-wrench for the screws.


**NB!** Make sure that the arrows on the stickers align and the colors match.

2 Repeat the process with the second set.




Attach both diagonal legs to the horizontal bars with **Type 1** screws. Use the **L-wrench** for the screws.

**NB!** Make sure that the screw holes in the middle of the diagonal legs are facing towards the plant stand. See the red circle.




Attach the felt bag with Type 2 screws.

The felt bag can hold your power adaptors, extensions and other accessories.



Although the unit is freestanding, we recommend mounting it to a wall for improved stability and safety.


 Attach the wall brackets to the underside of the upper shelf with Type 2 screws. **NB!** There are different types of screws for wooden, dry and stonewall with your Plant Stand. Please check the Parts List at the beginning of this manual.



- ② Place the Plant Stand against the wall you want to attach it to. Use a pencil to mark the screw holes on the wall (note the screwhole alignment drawing). Leave 2-3mm/0.08inch of screw heads unscrewed from the wall.
- 3 Mount the plant stand to the wall by slightly lifting the unit.

# Step 6

# Placing the Smart Gardens and fixing the cords.



Your Plant Stand is now fully assembled. Fit your Smart Garden 9s into the grooves on the shelves.

You can fit the cords into slots in the shelves and secure them to the back leg with provided **Cord fixators** for a cleaner look.

## **Pro Tips for A Perfect Garden**

#### Remember:

- Get the Click and Grow app from the App Store, Google Play or go to www.clickandgrow.com/activate
- Remove the germination domes once the plants have sprouted.
- Letting the plants grow too close to the lamp is not good for them.
- Keep the float level with the top of the garden. Add water when the float reaches the bottom. Make sure not to overfill!
- Keep the plastic plant cups and domes. They are reusable for your next growing experience.
- You can use the leftover space on the shelves (just behind the gardens) to store domes or accessories, so you don't lose them.

### You can expect sprouts to appear in 1-3 weeks.

Different plants grow at different paces, so some of them will sprout within a week, while others may take up to 3 weeks.

Be patient!

#### Personalize the lamp cycle.

The lamp has an automatic cycle: 16 hours on, 8 hours off. The cycle starts the minute you plug your lamp in. To reset the lamp's schedule, unplug the garden and then plug it in at the time of day when you want the cycle to start. It's as easy as that!
